In recent years, we deplore a series of dam failures.




## We need to build new large dams and maintain the old ones

## Dam safety is crucial for the future of dams

- Major accidents on every continent during the last two years :
  - Brazil, Colombia, USA in America
  - but also Laos, Russia, United Kingdom...

A World Declaration on Dam Safety is to be issued soon !!!



- ICOLD has drafted that declaration during the year 2019.
  - After consultation with the ICOLD National Committees
  - it has been finally approved by ICOLD Board.


